You may recall the story where after the resurrection, Jesus walked alongside two of His followers on the road to Emmaus. Initially, they were unable to recognize Him. However, when they sat down to share a meal, Jesus broke bread and prayed. In that moment, their eyes were opened and they recognized Him (Luke 24:31).


