Greetings YBA Family,

With the Summer Olympics just around the corner I wanted to share an Olympic story. Matthew Emmons is one of the best shooters in the history of American shooting. Across his 23-year career, the four-time Olympian has won numerous titles, including one gold, one

silver and one bronze at the Olympic Games, plus a gold and bronze medal at the World Championships.

But he might be better remembered for the Olympic gold medal that he didn't win.

Two days after winning the gold medal, Emmons stood on the stage of the men's 50m rifle three-position final, during which he had established a huge lead in the point standings, with a three-point lead over the second-placed athlete. Prior to the final shot, all he needed to do was hit the target to win his second gold medal. Then, the unthinkable happened. Emmons scored zero on his final shot after misfiring at another competitor's target. He shot at the wrong target. He blew the three-point lead, dropped to eighth overall. Now don't feel too bad for Emmons as he went on to win more medals, but this example should be one that the church today should hear. Obviously, the lesson here is to make sure you are shooting at the correct target. As a Christ follower what is your target, as a church what is your measuring stick of faithfulness?

What is the goal or the target we as Christ followers should be aiming at? Well, many people over the years have suggested that there are five purposes of the church. Here's the list: worship, fellowship, discipleship, ministry, and mission. I know in any group of pastors and theologians, there might be some who would want to add to this list and others who might take some away. But if we were to narrow that down to one thing, what is the mission of the church? I'm reminded of John 20:21 where Jesus said to His disciples, "as the Father has sent Me, I also send you." I have noticed a reoccurring theme in all my sermons over this past year. This theme is that we have been saved to be sent! You and I have been saved to be sent out and represent Christ to a lost world. We have been commissioned to share the Gospel message with a world that is literally dying to hear it.

God is at work here in our association. Here's one example of what God is doing in our area. Back in March of this year, the student pastor at Ridgecrest Baptist Church, Austin Tsumas, challenged the youth to have 500 Gospel conversations over the next year. To date, the students have shared the Gospel with 129 people.

In the past month, they have seen 5 people accept Christ and 18 others come forward for baptism. There was lady in her 60s who came to their first baptism service to support one of the students. After watching everyone get baptized, she was convicted by the Holy Spirit and went back to her home church (that is not Ridgecrest) to talk to her pastor about getting baptized as well. So that would make 19 people altogether who have come forward for baptism!

The majority of the people who have come forward for baptism are students in grades 7th-12th grade. However, a few college age students have come forward as well. Will you stop and thank God for what He is doing with these students and pray that it will be contagious!



One of my favorite sports quotes comes from NHL Hall of Famer, Wayne Gretzky. He said "You miss 100 percent of the shots you don't take." Today I am praying that you will aim at the right goal and you will take the shot. Share the Good News of the Gospel with someone today.
