Greetings YBA Family,

There's a story about a city guy who is driving in the country and has a deer run directly in front of his car. To avoid crashing into the deer, he swerves and gets stuck in a ditch. He tries to get out but cannot get the car to move at all. About this time an old farmer comes by with a horse. The farmer asks the city man if he and his horse "Buddy" can be of assistance. The man says of course that would be great.

So, the farmer hooks up a rope to the car, gets his horse Buddy out in front, and then he says, "Pull Nelly, pull!" The city guy says to himself, I thought his name was Buddy. So, nothing happens...

Then the farmer calls out, "Pull Roscoe, pull!" But Buddy just stands still, and the driver of the car is thinking "Is this guy all there?"

Then for a third time the farmer yells, "Pull Lightening, pull!" Three times and nothing happened.

Finally, on the fourth time the farmer calls out, "Pull Buddy pull!" And boom... the car comes right out of the ditch. The driver thanks the farmer then says, "I'm curious why you called three other names before you called the horse's name. Why would you do that?"

The farmer explains well you see, Buddy's blind and if he thinks he's pulling all by himself he won't do anything. But if there's a team around him. He'll pull like there's no tomorrow.

This past week I had the privilege of attending the Disciple Making Conference in High Point. This is an annual event that the Baptist State Convention hosts. It was a great time to be reminded and challenged to be about the task of the making disciples, but also to be reminded that we are not alone. I saw many friends and colleagues from across the state who are ready to make a difference in the lives of their communities.

When I was growing up, there was a very clear strategy that almost all churches used. Maybe some of you remember it. I like to call it the "Field of Dreams" strategy. This movie came out back in the 1990s and one of the most famous lines in the movie is; "If you build it, they will come." So, I'm not going to spoil the movie by telling you what that means but for so long that was our strategy in the church. We thought if we can build bigger buildings, or develop more programs or promote bigger events, then people would come to our churches.

This strategy worked great when people identified with the church or when the church was the center of the community, but our world and our context has changed radically. We cannot go back in time, but we can make the most of time today!

According to Gallup Polls, over 1/3 of all Americans now identify as non-religious saying that religion is not an important part of their daily life and they rarely, if ever, attend any religious services. Christianity Today reported a few years ago that the fastest growing religious segment in the United States was a group called the "nones." These are not catholic ladies in long brown robes, but people who don't identify with any faith tradition whatsoever. When they fill out the surveys and the question asks "religion" they simply say NONE.

Right here in our state of North Carolina, the Baptist State Convention has done research to show us that anywhere from 75 to 80% of all people who live in the Research Triangle area are far from God. Think about that, let that sink in for a moment. Three out of every four people you encounter are lost and without hope.

We must change our strategy from a "Y'all Come" to "Let's Go." We have already been sent. It is not the Great Suggestion or even the Great Option. We have been Commissioned. It is a mandate from our Commander telling us to go and share the GOOD NEWS to a dying world.

Over the past few weeks I have been reflecting on my time and work here at YBA. God has done and is doing some great things. But I am very aware that we must make the most of every day to advance God's Kingdom and share the Gospel. Through different avenues God has reminded me that our role here at YBA is to help the local church fulfill its call to take the Gospel. I want to be more focused on the Gospel and how it can transform communities, counties and countries. We used the "Y'all Come" and "If you Build it, they will come" strategies, now we must get back to making a difference in our communities by getting back into our communities. This past week I heard Dr. Steven Wade say, "Discipleship is not a destination, it is a journey." Let's journey together!





"Loving Oaxaca"

Oaxaca July 2020 Student Mission Trip July 25 to August 1 April 30 deadline for \$200 deposit

OAXACA (pronounced Wa-ha-ka) is located in southeastern Mexico. It is a beautiful mountainous state populated with a number of indigenous people groups. Over the last few centuries they have accepted the religious beliefs of their ancestors and joined together with Catholicism to create a syncretistic religion.



This ritualistic and animistic belief system leaves them confused and separated from God's grace. Oaxaca needs to hear about Jesus. Many have been lied to and they desperately need to hear the truth. Oaxaca is a great place for your students to learn about missions and participate in the Gospel advance.

As a part of the Associational partnership with Oaxaca Mexico, YBA is sponsoring an International Student trip this summer. This trip is for students age 16-21. Students not 16 on July 25 can come but a parent or guardian must accompany them.

The week will be set up much like a camp setting. The students will have a worship service and bible study each morning then divide into their work teams and plan for the day. Each afternoon the teams will be doing a variety of ministries in a VBS like setting. Activities such as Sports and English Camps, Door to Door evangelism, Basic First Aid, Developing Good Health Habits, Safety in the Home, etc. We will be working with local churches in the city of Oaxaca to reach their neighborhoods. We will return every evening and have worship time together.

Estimated cost is \$600 plus airfare and includes hotel, food, insurance, local transportation. (Airfare is estimated at \$650, so total cost of trip will be around \$1250).

We are hoping to have a large number of students go with us, but we do have a limited number of participants so please make your reservation as soon as possible. 
