Greetings YBA Family,

Let me ask you a question. Have you ever needed something and you really didn't know it until you got it? Maybe you got home exhausted and you took an afternoon nap even though you never take naps. But when you woke up you felt so refreshed and you said, "Wow, I really needed that!"

Well, I just got back from the Disciple-Making Conference in Greensboro that the BSCNC sponsors every year, and boy was it just what I needed!

Honestly, for the weeks leading up to it, I kept trying to talk myself out of going. I wrestled with the whole COVID-19 guidelines and protocols. I asked myself, "Do I want to put myself in the middle of a large group?" I justified not going by thinking, "It's probably stuff I've heard before. Do I really have time to miss a day of work to attend?"

All of the speakers were excellent, but God used Vance Pitman to speak directly to me. I'm not going to give you his complete message, but the general gist for me personally was God asking me this question: "How much longer are you going to use COVID as an excuse?"

Pittman stated that we are living in an unparalleled time in human history. He went on to say that "moments of crises are always opportunities for the church to make Jesus known and invite others into His kingdom."

In retrospect, God has been reminding me over the past months that we are called to a specific task. The great commission is not the great suggestion. We have been commanded by our Lord to go and make disciples. There is no small print that says, "Oh, don't worry during a pandemic." The mandate still applies today. We have been called to effectively share the good news of the gospel and invest our time in making disciples of all nations.

Pittman has written a book titled Unburdened. The subtitle of the book says, "Stop living for Jesus so Jesus can live through you." Wow, stop and think about that statement. How many times do we find ourselves striving so hard for Jesus but we're not allowing him to work and live through us?

I'm reminded in John 15:5, Jesus said, "I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing." Did you catch the Great Commission reference there? We are called to bear "much fruit." But that fruit cannot come until we learn to abide in Him and allow Him to live through us.

A few weeks ago, a trusted colleague shared that he believed that this newsletter was not being maximized. After careful thought, I've come to the conclusion that he is right. In the coming months we look forward to sharing stories of how the mission is being completed and what challenges are here in front of us.

This reminds me of a story by Tony Evans. He tells the story of going out to see a friend's farm. The farm was huge and beautiful. There were cattle and horses and almost every animal you could imagine on a farm. But there was something unusual about the red barn. Now obviously a red barn on a farm is not unusual. But after doing the whole tour they got close to the barn and he noticed that they were seven bullseyes painted on the side of the barn. As Tony got a little closer, he noticed that in the dead center of each bullseye there was a single bullet hole. Tony asked, "What's this all about? Who did this?" His friend shrugged his shoulders and said, "I did."

Tony asks, "Where were you when you took the shots? The farmer pointed up on the hill about 400 yards away. Tony was so surprised he said, "I didn't know you were a sharpshooter. Were you in the military?" "No," the farmer answered. "You don't understand. You see, one day I went hunting and I didn't have any luck and I was frustrated so on my way back I saw the barn and I just started shooting at it. Then later I went over and I painted bullseyes around the holes that I had shot on the side of the barn."

This story reminds me that sometimes that's what we do with God. We want to tell God, "Lord, this is my best shot, my plan," instead of asking Him what He wants us to do. Or in our case remembering what He has already told us to do. "Make Disciples."

It's like striving and trying so hard to live for Jesus that we have forgotten to allow Him to live through us. It's like struggling so hard to know what God wants us to do when He's already told us very clearly to go and make disciples.

What is your target? Make sure you're shooting at the right one.
