They are missionaries working among Muslim unreached people groups and your association has the privilege to partner with them in an amazing ministry. They work with Global Gates, a missions agency here in North America. The Benfield family live and minister daily here in Durham and the greater Triangle. For the

past few years, YBA has had the privilege to partner with them for the advance of the Gospel among unreached people groups right here in our backyard.

I hope to share more with you about the ministries and partnerships here at YBA. I asked them to share briefly a profile of who they are and what they're doing, check this out...



We are the Benfields.

Will you pray with us as we deliver the Gospel to unreached people groups (UPGs) in Raleigh/ Durham? Our work involves evangelism, discipleship & church planting among the world's least reached peoples from the Muslim world that have made their way to live in our community!

Through this ministry, many of these people will gain gospel access for the first time. Our ministry is a partnership with our Global Gates team members and

local churches who are on mission with us. Together we are catalysts for gospel advance!

In 2022 we will be focusing on three groups, primarily:

- 1. The Wolof of Senegal and Gambia
- 2. Moroccans
- 3. Afghan Refugees

A big part of our role is to mobilize, train, equip & send God's church to be on mission; we can't do it alone! Churches are beginning to come alongside us & join in the work!


