GUESS What? It's September! Are you kidding me? I remember hearing people say, "Time flies," and, as a kid and young man, I thought they were crazy. But research shows that your brain's internal clock runs slower as you age, which makes the pace of life appear to quicken.

There are various theories about why time seems to go faster as you get older. One gerontologist (a person who studies the aging process) said, "As you get older, each year is a smaller percentage of your life. If you are 10 years old, a year is 10 percent. If you are 50 years old, a year is two percent. When you're 75...well, you get the picture.

Every September, we take up an offering called the North Carolina Missions Offering (NCMO). The sad news is that most people don't know much about the NCMO. So, let me take this opportunity to share a little information about the NCMO.

The title NCMO is a little bit of a misnomer because not all of these funds are used in North Carolina. Although a good part of this offering is for our state, a significant part of these funds go to help both national and international ministries. Your gifts to the NCMO support Baptists on Missions (many of you may know them as Baptist Men), which helps provide disaster relief, such as rebuilding homes after a hurricane, here in North Carolina and throughout the U.S. as well as internationally. Did you know that one of our YBA pastors came here through strategic connections with North Carolina Baptists in Central America, who came to help after a disaster? **Forty-one percent of this offering goes to Baptists on Mission.**

When you give to the North Carolina Missions Offering, you enable men, women and students to be involved with hands-on ministries such as disaster relief, medical missions, direct evangelism and church planting. All of these ministries work with a single goal of helping people know Jesus as Lord and Savior.

Just this past year, disaster relief teams from N.C. served on critical missions from war-torn Ukraine to the recent flooding in Kentucky, and to numerous sites within our state devastated by natural disasters. Although COVID-19 has impacted the numbers, Baptists on Missions average over 2,000 volunteers a year involved in projects here in the U.S. and over 1,000 volunteers serving in international projects.

Twenty-eight percent of the NCMO goes to help church planting right here in N.C. Did you know that North Carolina Baptists saw 45 new churches planted last year? With over 4,000 Baptist churches in North Carolina and many churches struggling, I often hear "why do we need to plant new churches?" The reason is that new churches are one of the most effective ways to reach new people with the gospel. Also, new churches help our existing churches to remember the mission that we are called to finish. We are called to make disciples, and one of the best ways to do this is through starting new churches.

Fifteen percent goes to Mission Camps where adults and students can have a first-time experience learning what it means to be the hands and feet of Christ in a close-to-home setting. We currently have mission camps in Red Springs and Shelby, N.C.

And you might be surprised to learn that **10 percent goes back to the local association.** Each year, 10 percent of the NCMO collected in each local association is distributed back to that association. For example, if YBA churches gave \$50,000, \$5,000 of that would come back to YBA for strategic mission efforts through the association.

Finally, 6 percent goes to Mobilization Ministry projects. These funds help to mobilize men, women and students to use their God-given talents and gifts to serve in many ways. This past year over 1,200 volunteers served on 113 different teams through North American mission partners. Your gifts allow more people to participate.

One of the saddest things I have learned in recent days is that only about one-third of the churches in the N.C. give to this offering. Let me encourage you and your church to support this important offering this month.

Just as a final thought and prayer request, I will be leaving on September 4th with 5 pastors from YBA and 3 others from the state to do a Pastors Training in Armenia. This trip is in partnership with Baptists on Mission, and we are benefiting from this offering as we are "On Mission Together" in Armenia.

The theme for 2022 is "Relief for today. Hope for tomorrow." The offering goal is \$2.1 million. Here is the theme verse:

Romans 15:13 "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope."


