July represents a moment where we find ourselves half way through 2023. It's hard to believe that today we are closer to 2024 than 2022. Obviously, July is the biggest vacation month of the year but many of our churches are busy with mission trips, youth camps, and Vacation Bible Schools, as well as serving and making deeper connections in the community. If you are reading this during the first week of July, then my wife

Melissa and I are serving in Oaxaca, Mexico. We are here with a group of almost 20 people from the TriWest network, working together with a larger group of almost 60 people from several states who are working with church plants around the city of Oaxaca, Mexico. One of my greatest pleasures over the last few decades is watching students go on international mission trips and have their eyes opened and their minds blown to see what God can do, and that He can use them!

Just two weeks ago, I had the opportunity to share at Camp Caraway with about 150 elementary students about the Biblical basis for missions. I had chosen 24 different scripture references to walk them through the Bible from Genesis to Revelation. My plan was to show them how God had called His people to be about sharing the Good News to a lost and dying world through the entire Bible. I was going to start in Genesis 12 where God calls Abraham to leave his people and go to a place that He will show him. God told Moses, I will bless you... and all the peoples of the earth will be blessed through you.

I was going to walk through the Old Testament demonstrating God's desire to impact all people groups. I had numerous passages picked out through the New Testament to show God's overall plan was to redeem a lost world through Jesus and then use His church to live on mission for that end. I planned to finish in Revelation 7:9 where the apostle John had the vision of heaven. He said, "after this, I looked and there was a vast multitude from every nation, tribe, people, and language, which no one could number standing before the throne, and before the Lamb".

So, I was ready to do a Missional Bible Drill to get through all those passages in just 25 minutes with elementary students! Then I got up and did my devotional before heading to the Caraway. I read Psalm 117. This Psalm is the shortest psalm as well as the shortest chapter in all the Bible. It has just two verses.

It reads, "Praise the Lord, all nations! Extol Him, all peoples! For great is His steadfast love toward us, and the faithfulness of the Lord endures forever. Praise the Lord!" Psalm 117:1-2 ESV

As I was preparing to go and speak to these children, I felt as if God was showing me that I didn't need to impress the children with Bible knowledge or oversaturate the children with all the verses that I had prepared. Because here in these two short verses, it summarizes the story of all the Bible. Isn't that just like our God, to make it simple and profound at the same time.

As we rightfully celebrate July 4th and thank God for the freedom we enjoy, we must remember that God is concerned about all people and all nations on the Earth. The word "Extol" in the ESV version means praise, but the Greek word also means to celebrate. As we stop and celebrate America, would you stop and celebrate and praise the one true God. It's clear from the beginning to the end of the Bible that God desires to be praised by all people. I don't understand why, but amazingly, He has chosen to use you and me and His bride, the church, to share the Good News of the Gospel with every nation, every people, every language, and every tribe.


